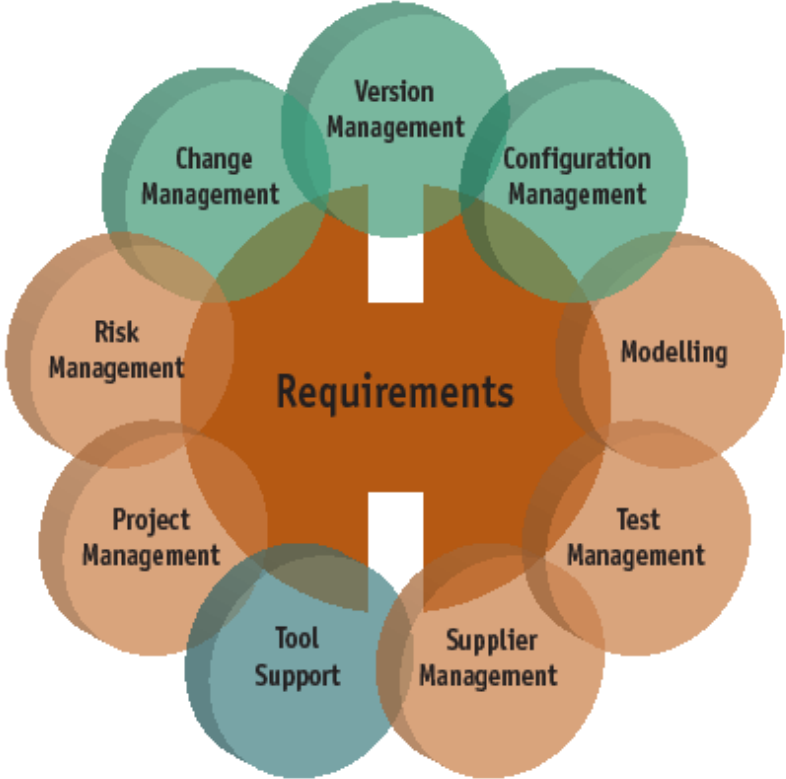

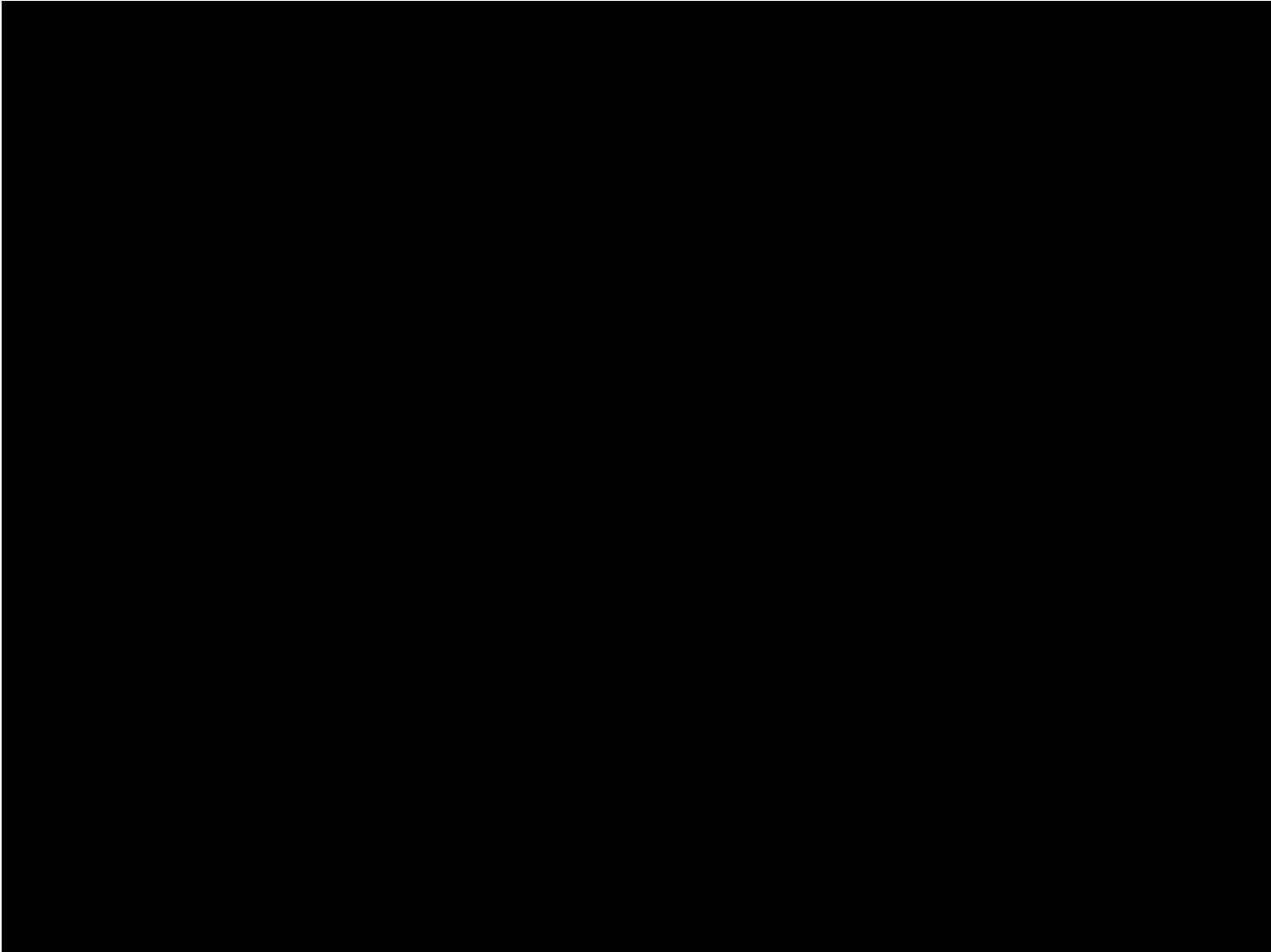

version management	Individual items are frozen (versioned) as necessary, versions can be identified	configurations are versioned	Version plan is created including rules for versioning

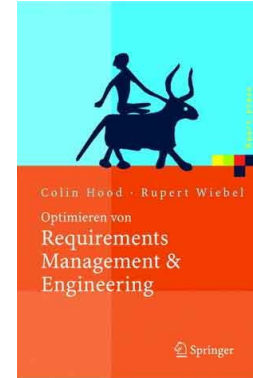
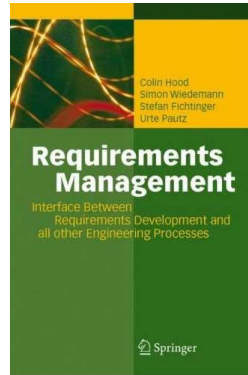
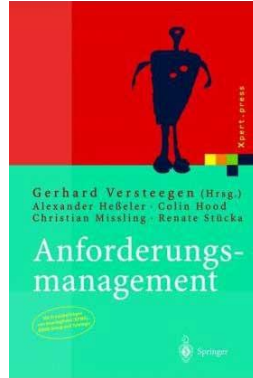
